## What I do on Campus

The main goal of FOCUS is to launch college students into *lifelong* Catholic mission. We do this by Jesus' model of spiritual multiplication in which we "teach teachers to teach" (2 Timothy 2:2). This involves "discipling" students – praying for them, sharing life with them, inviting them into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, and equipping them to lead Bible studies and reach other students on campus to likewise disciple them and lead them closer to Christ. I currently disciple 6 girls, 5 of whom are leading a Bible study and discipling one or more girls this semester and one who I just asked into discipleship this semester!

## Fall Outreach

Fall outreach is what we call those first couple of months when my teammates and I, alongside our student leaders, focus on meeting as many students as possible through various fun events.

Some of our fall outreach events included setting up tables along campus to invite students to join a Bible study, bowling at the student union, movie night at the Catholic Center, tubing down a river, s'mores night, and a concert in the female missionaries' backyard (pictured above). Fall outreach proved to be very successful as we had countless students show up for our fun events to meet other students and enjoy fellowship in the faith as well as about 350 students sign up for Bible studies!
